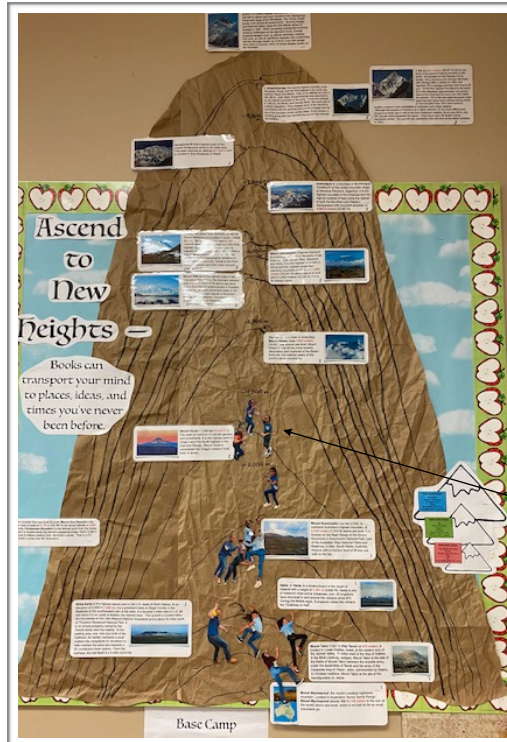

A language I wish I could speak is Shona.

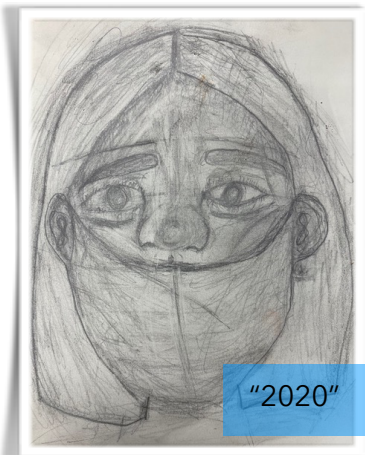
If I were a teacher, I'd teach my students how to write.
