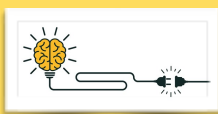

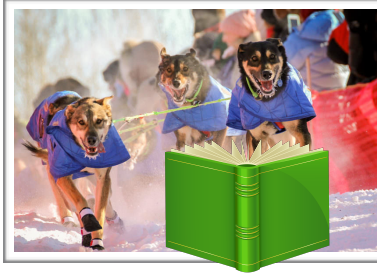


Chuckle Bits

Is Nome in Your Sights?

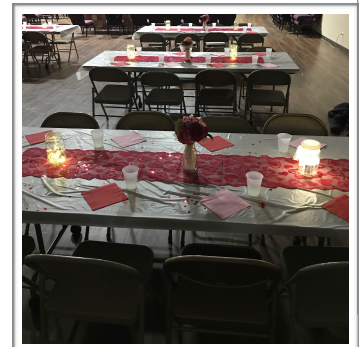
