## Investment Missions Fair

The mission fair is this Saturday evening at 6:30. I have received a number of items already from those who have been working away to provide for good shopping! Thank you! If you do not have anything to bring to sell, just bring yourself. And if you have some money and would like to use it to support mission work there will be plenty of ways to do that. The two projects we have selected for this year are:

- 1) Tanzy (a graduate of MOVE who is ministering in Ghana) would like to provide children there with a complete outfit of clothing. Many of them have just one set of clothes. She has done her homework and things she can supply a complete outfit,

including shoes, for just \$8 per child.

- 2) Persistent drought in Cambodia has caused many water sources to run dry. Without enough water, rural communities can't raise crops or cattle along with being challenged to keep themselves clean. Your dollars at the mission fair will help provide wells for communities served by ASAP missionaries and hopefully restore communities and open hearts to receive the Water of Life. The cost per well is \$770-\$2,070. We would love to fully sponsor at least one well. There is need for nine wells.

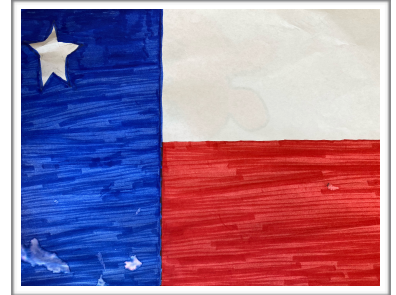
