Grades 3-9, please get your yarn and crochet hook (H,I, or J) if you haven't done so yet.

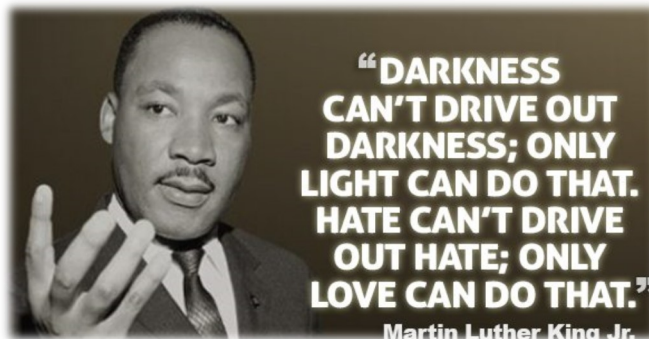


Amen Pantry

Happy Heart Banquet

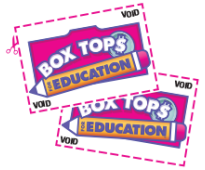

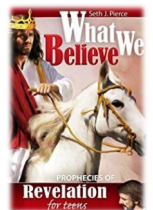

If I were to pick a different name for myself, it'd be: still Josiah

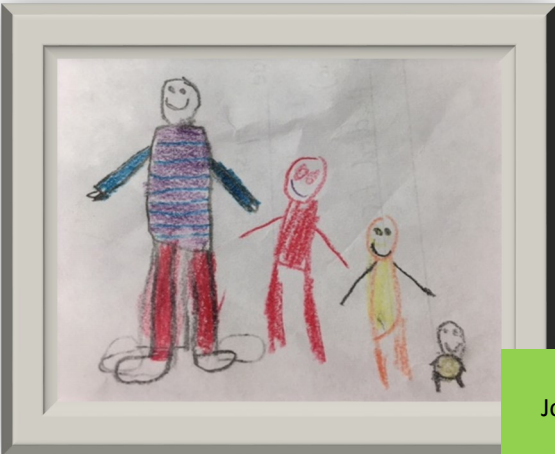
Best age to be is an adult like 51 because of worshipping God

Did You Know?
