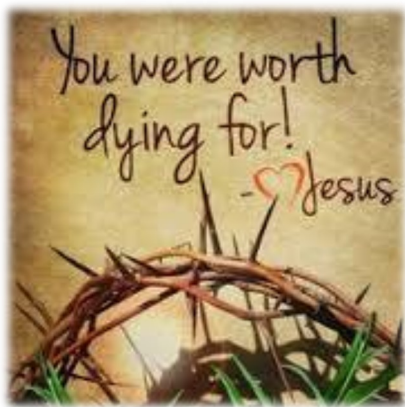
Amen Pantry

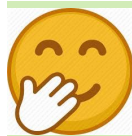
