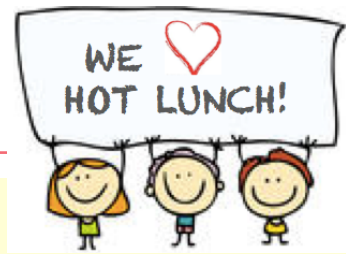

Reiss: 1 loaf 100% whole wheat bread

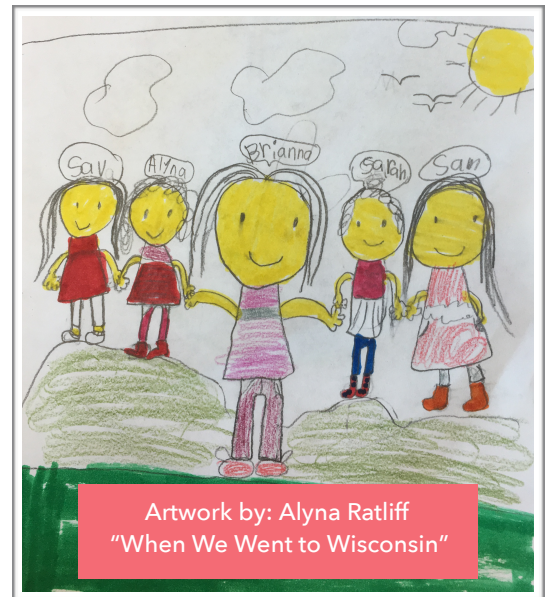

Atira: 1 bottle Ranch dressing

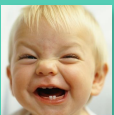
