God said, "No. You must grow on your own, but I will prune you to make you fruitful."

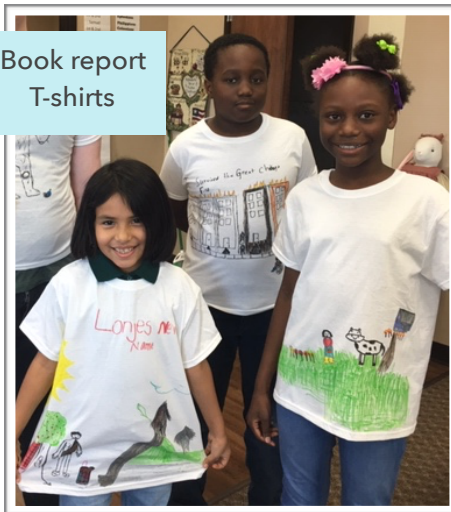
I asked God for all things that I might enjoy life.

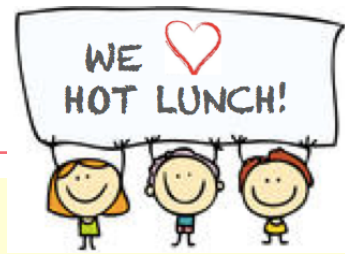

- Worst smell: grass

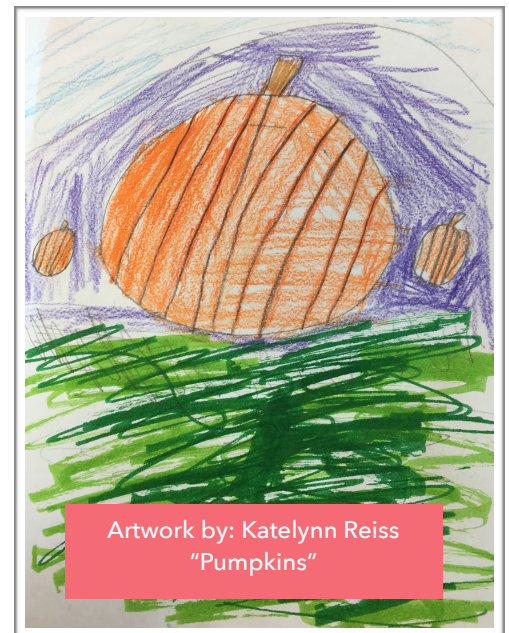
- A hero of mine is God because He made us

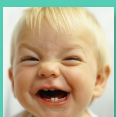
